All horses must have passports per FEI rules:

- All horses in the 1* or 2* events MUST have National (or FEI) passports.

General Rules and Regulations (continued) Pg 5

STABLING: The Ranch has 375 10X10 permanent box stalls with doors. They will NOT convert any stalls to double stalls. Single stalls/Tack Rooms are \$300 (total) for Tuesday through Sun 18:00. While daily cleaning is each individual's responsibility, the Ranch will strip stalls at end of event. There are wash rack and electricity readily available. Bedding \$10/bale in advance, \$12 at the event. **No outside bedding per facility.** Please notify management if you would like to stay late. The Ranch may have early arrival available this year. Contact management for assistance in finding early arrival stabling

FEED: Competitors provide their own hay/feed. Hay/feed can be purchased locally at market prices by the competitors

ARENAS: Competition will be held in the covered arena. All vaulting circles will meet or exceed 20 x 25 meters. There will be two or three warm-up circles in the competition arena. An adjacent arena will be available for horse warm up under saddle and for lunging.

FOOTING: Kiser Engineered footing (indoor) and a dirt/sand mix (outdoor) We are in process of changing to a sand and shaving mix. Awaiting facility approval

FOOD: Will be sold onsite either through Spectra or local food trucks COVID regulations at the time of the event dictating. There are several restaurants in walking distance and many more with a 5-minute drive

PETS: No dogs or other pets allowed. Certified service animals are permitted

AWARDS: 1-3 for each Event. Additional Awards per Management Decision. Prize-giving Ceremony as COVID precautions allow. Vaulters/Loungers must be in appropriate attire. See FEI Definite Schedule at www.RockyMtnCup.org

MUSIC: Music must be uploaded through HorseSport.pro. Music must be uploaded by Wednesday June 7th. Directions for uploading to horsesport.pro to follow

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF
Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives,
executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual repre-sentations pursuant to
this Agreement (the "Agreement"): A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations,
and policies of USEF as published in the USEF Rule Book and on the website at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time. B.
ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of
equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any
USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones,
head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability,
paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable
behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers
or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities
issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of
varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other


